- Self-management goes hand in hand with self-awareness so that you are able to control your own emotions and not being controlled by them.
- Social awareness is the ability to accurately read situations and people.

 This can only occur when you are aware of your own emotions. An important part of social awareness is the ability to empathize with the







Event Report:

From the 2nd to the 6th of March, 2020, the Department of Computer Application hosted a one-week Faculty Development Program (FDP). The FDP on "Machine Learning with Python," a cutting-edge technology, was organised for MCA and BCA professors.

On Day 1, the training began with an introductory session. Dr.Krishan and the resource persons were handed seedlings as a warm greeting. Prof.Priya Thomas, Convener, gave a welcome talk and explained the concept of the FDP to the audience.

Introduction to Python and problem solving in Python were the topics addressed in session 1 on Day 1. Pandas for handling datasets, Numpys for using mathematics libraries, and Matplotlib for visualisation using Jupyter notebook were covered in Session 2. The trainer taught the concept for each piece of content before participants put it into practise.

On Day 2, the first and second sessions discussed Machine Learning and its classification. The sessions discussed machine learning algorithms for prediction.

Image processing, face recognition, and an introduction to deep learning were among the subjects covered in sessions 1 and 2 on Day 3.

On Day 4, the trainer continued the topic of deep learning in session 1 and covered the concepts of feed forward and back propagation, text analysis/NLP using Tensor flow, and sentiment analysis using Tensor flow in session 2.

Advanced subjects such as Long Short Term Memory (LSTM) and Generative Adversial Networks (GAN) were covered on Day 5.

For greater clarity, all of the algorithms covered by FDP were also explained through a thorough hands-on session.

The FDP ended with a thanks giving ceremony by the Principal.
