- 5. To uphold Women's Right to Protection against Sexual Harassment and for the prevention and redressal of sexual harassment of women.
- 6. To evolve a permanent mechanism for the prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women at KGI.
- 7. To actively promote a social, physical and psychological environment that will raise awareness about and deter acts of sexual harassment of women.
- 8. To undertake all necessary and reasonable steps including the constitution of appropriate committees for purposes of gender sensitization and to conduct enquiries into complaints of sexual harassment.

The programme was conducted on 26th September 2017 in Sparta at 2:00pm. The programme was organized and well-managed by the MBA Batch 2018-2020. The event kick started by the Welcome Address by Aabhiya Karki [MBA IInd Yr. {HR}]. The Key address to the programme was presided by Prof Rama Lakshmi, Academic Coordinator MBA Department]. A video of types of Internal Compliants and its effects was played in order to sensivitize students about the potent harms on human-life. Students were provided the opportunity to share their insights, values, and views on complaints. Alvin Martin Jacob [MBA IInd Yr. {FIN.}] and Ms. Ambily Jose [new joinee] spoke on the internal complaince effects which caught the audience's attention and applause. 
REPORT ON ANTI SEXUAL HARASSMENT CELL OCTOBER 2017

An Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell meeting was convened on 16th of October 2017, to schedule an Anti-Sexual Harassment awareness session under the leadership of Principal of MBA department. Dr. Shagufta Showkat, as a chairperson and spokesperson discussed about the Prevention of sexual harassment. She has discussion the complete procedure of registering a complaint. When a designated person receives a complaint of sexual harassment, he/she will immediately record the dates, times and facts of the incident(s), ascertain the views of the victim as to what outcome he/she wants, ensure that the victim understands the company's procedures for dealing with the complaint, discuss and agree the next steps: either informal or formal complaint, on the understanding that choosing to resolve the matter informally does not preclude the victim from pursuing a formal complaint if he/she is not satisfied with the outcome, keep a confidential record of all discussions, respect the choice of the victim, ensure that the victim knows that they can lodge the complaint outside of the company through the relevant country/legal framework. It is important to give the victim option. No Anti Sexual Harassment case was reported in the ongoing semester.
