- 4. To comply with the provisions of the Sexual Harassment at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (Act) and to develop and implement a policy against sexual harassment of women at the KGI.
- 5. To uphold Women's Right to Protection against Sexual Harassment and for the prevention and redressal of sexual harassment of women.
- 6. To evolve a permanent mechanism for the prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women at KGI.
- 7. To actively promote a social, physical and psychological environment that will raise awareness about and deter acts of sexual harassment of women.
- 8. To undertake all necessary and reasonable steps including the constitution of appropriate committees for purposes of gender sensitization and to conduct enquiries into complaints of sexual harassment.

#### Report on Awareness Programme for Girls at KGI

The Awareness Programme aimed for Girls at KGI at educating the newly admitted students and the seniors batch about Spreading awareness among the students about the social, legal and constitutional rights of women in order to prevent the exploitation based on gender. The ICC Cell, its functions, process, committee members, helpline and emergency contact numbers, ICC squads, surprise checks, penal laws, process of filing complaint, Hostel vigilance, etc. to ensure a culture of compliant free environment. The programme was conducted on 24th September 2018 in Sparta at 2:00pm. The programme was organized and well-managed by the MBA Batch 2018-2020. The event kick started by the Welcome Address by Ms. Tahira Tidiwala [MBA IInd Yr. {HR}]. The Key address to the programme was presided by Dr. Pravesh Soti [Principal, MBA Department]. A video of types of Internal Compliants and its effects was played in order to sensivitize students about the potent harms on human-life. Students were provided the opportunity to share their insights, values, and views on complaints. 






#### Report on Workplace Treatment of Women in the KGI campus
