

Krupanidhi Group of Institutionssystematised an awareness program on World Aids Day, the college authority decided to celebrate the occasion on, 1st of December. The awareness program was planned and Sparta was selected as the yenue for the occasion.HIV is an abbreviation for human immunodeficiency virus; the term "HIV" can refer to either the virus itself or the HIV infection it causes. AIDS is an abbreviation for acquired immunodeficiency syndrome and is the last stage of HIV infection.HIV attacks important cells in your immune system, called CD4 or T cells, that fight infections. As HIV destroys CD4 cells, it becomes harder for your body to fight off infections. Eventually, HIV can destroy the immune system and progress to AIDS if not treated. To make everyone aware of the same Creative team made Ribbons and tied them to the entire classroom as well as the Entire Management taking their signature making them aware of them same and putting lights to the importance of the day.





Dean of Management Studies Dr. Sarita Iyer Ma'amdelivered speech on The Spread of HIV.

To reduce the risk of becoming infected with HIV by practicing the following safe behaviour's. She openly spoke about some important point such as:

- Correctly use condoms every time you have sex
- Limit the number of sexual partners
- Never share equipment for injecting drugs



She also spoke about the Stages of HIV

There are three stages of HIV infection: acute HIV infection, clinical latency and AIDS. The infection gets worse as it progresses, eventually overwhelming your immune system without proper treatment. Progression through the stages occurs at different rates depending on a number of factors.

Stage 1: Acute HIV Infection

Two to four weeks after getting infected with HIV, people may develop severe flu-like symptoms. This is the acute HIV infection stage, which is also sometimes called "primary HIV infection" or "acute retroviral syndrome."

Stage 2: Clinical Latency

After the initial acute stage, HIV moves into the clinical latency stage, sometimes called "chronic HIV infection" or "asymptomatic HIV infection." Even though people are free of symptoms during the clinical latency stage, it's still possible to transmit HIV to others; treatment helps reduce this risk.



Stage 3: AIDS

In the final stage of HIV infection, the immune system is badly damaged and the body becomes vulnerable to opportunistic infections.

Indian Constitution Day



Krupanidhi Group of Institutions celebrated a cultural program on the occasion of Constitution Day also known as National Law Day, the college authority decided to celebrate the event on 29th of November. The program was planned and Sparta was selected as the venue for the event.

At first the Masters of Ceremony of the event Shayesta Salauddin and Shilpa Bharti gave an intro speech regarding our Constitution.

The Constitution of India was drafted between December 1946 and December 1949 – the most challenging period. This was the time when religious riots, caste wars, and entrenched gender inequality were threatening the social fabric of the country.

Afterwards, Professor Ramalakshmi Ma'am inaugurated the occasion by lighting the ceremonial lamp. Subsequently, Ma'am delivered a 10-minute speech on the significance of The Constitution of India.

After the mesmerizing speech, the Preamble of The Constitution was recited in command by Debojyoti Laha and all were requested to please rise as we honour India with the singing of our National Anthem.

Afterwards, Aparna S and Darshana Das quoted some interesting facts about our Constitution.

- The Constitution was formed by the Constituent Assembly. The 389-member assembly (reduced to 299 after the partition of India) took almost three years to draft the Constitution, holding eleven sessions over a 165-day period.
- It was on December 9, 1946 that the Constituent Assembly met for the first time.
- BR Ambedkar is recognised as the Father of the Constitution of India.
- The assembly's final session convened on 24 January 1950. Each member signed two copies of the constitution, one in Hindi and the other in English.
- The original constitution is hand-written by Prem Behari in flowing Italic style, with each page decorated by artists from Shantiniketan including Beohar Rammanohar Sinha and Nandalal Bose.
- It is the longest constitution in the world. In its current form, it has a Preamble, 22 parts with 448 Articles, 12 Schedules, 5 Appendices and 115 Amendments.

The National Emblem was adopted on January 26, 1950, when India was Aclared a republic.

The then Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru moved the "Objectives Resolution" on December 13, 1946, which was later adopted as the Preamble on January 22, 1947.

Three exclusive copies of the Indian Constitution are being preserved in special helium-filled cases at the Central Library of the Parliament, they are 22 inches long and 16 inches wide.

After the fascinating speech, a vote of thanks was given to thank all the people who helped to make this event successful.






SAY NO TO TOBACCO DAY Celebrated at Department of MBA, KGI Bangalore
